- High staff turnover
- Responsiveness to issues
- Cost of management fees

#### >>> Conflicts of interest

- Commissions
- Relationships with developers and strata councils
- Disclosure requirements

- Lack of industry-wide standards
- Licensing or registration regime
- Accountability
- Audits of trust accounts

- Need for more education and experience
- Better knowledge of the Strata Titles Act
